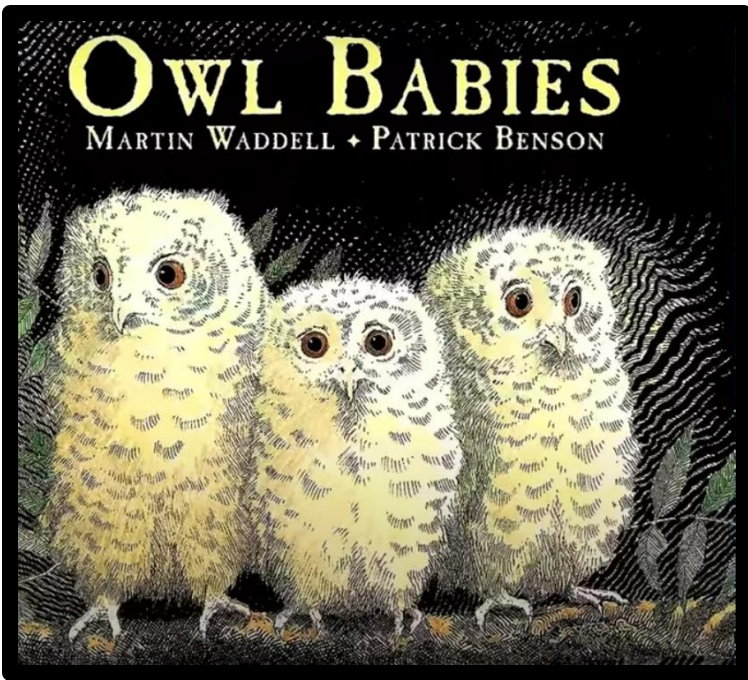
We hope all the Dads and Grandads had a special Father's Day and enjoyed the gifts the students made.
